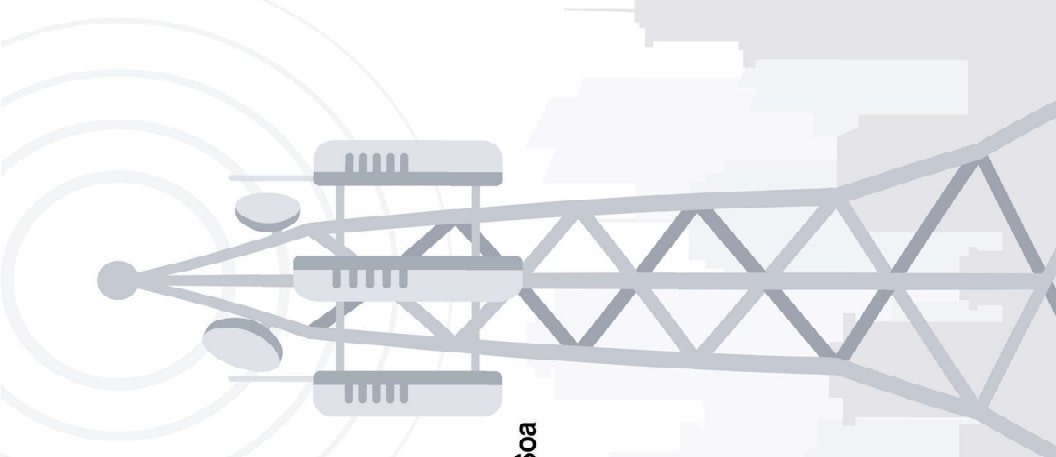
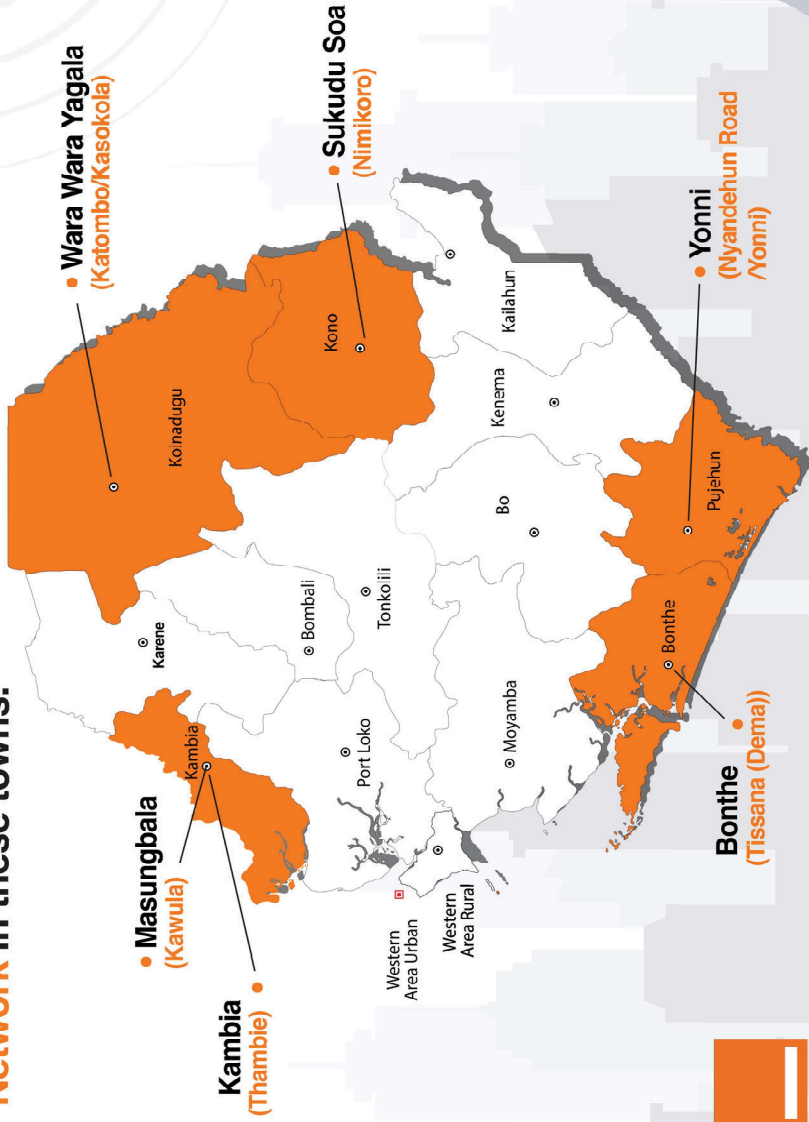


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Our CSR Story

We remain a major contributor to the Socio-economic development of the Country through our tax contributions and investment in Human Resources and CSR.

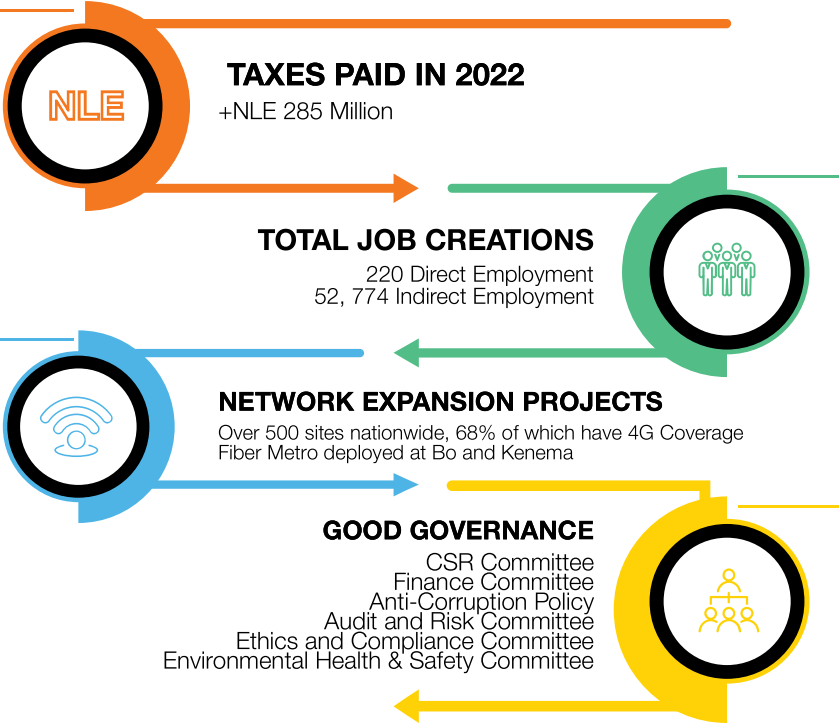
In 2022, our CSR and Orange Foundation contributions amounted to approximately NLe 11million.

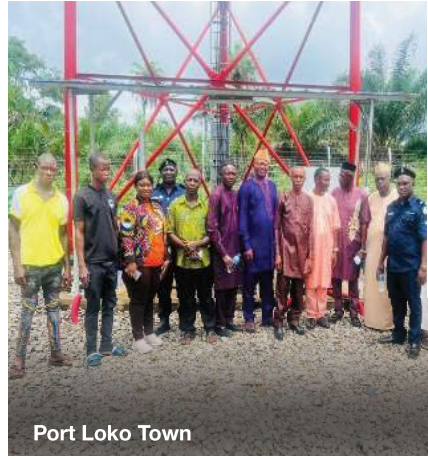

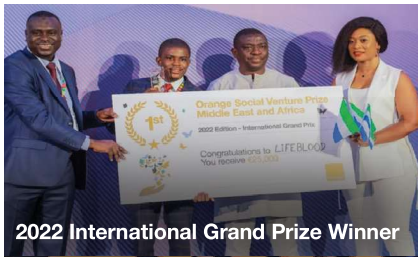

lack of essentials, we help to provide access to education, healthcare and promote culture for those in our society who would not otherwise have access, not to mention the socially excluded and unemployed. ”



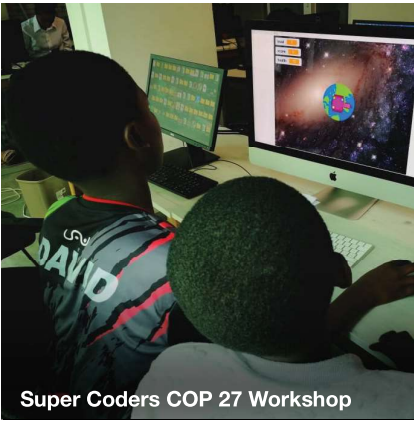

Women Digital Centre

Digital training to empower women without qualifications

WDC is a digital and entrepreneurial educational Group project that kicked off in 2021 in Sierra Leone with NAYCOM as our Implementing Partner. It is designed for vulnerable Women, inclusive of drop out Girls & semi-Literate Women. We trained them on ICT; Life Skills; Personal Competency; Entrepreneurship & Business Plan Development Training; Transformational Leadership; Communication Skills; Interpersonal Skills and Conflict Resolution.

126 Vulnerable Women have graduated from the 1st Cohort while 146 is presently undergoing similar training. Such training brings immense potential to improve social and economic outcomes for women in Sierra Leone by enabling them

to be more informed by being digitally literate. They become more aware by having access to the internet and this information leads to women making more informed choices in life and motivates them each day to learn something new and develop new skills and interests.

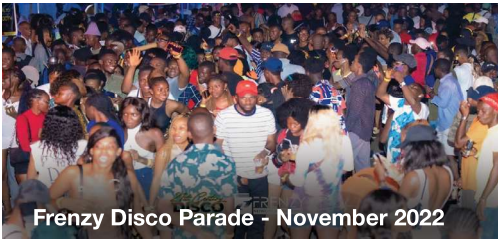

- Bank to Wallet and Wallet to Bank: Perform Mobile banking transactions.

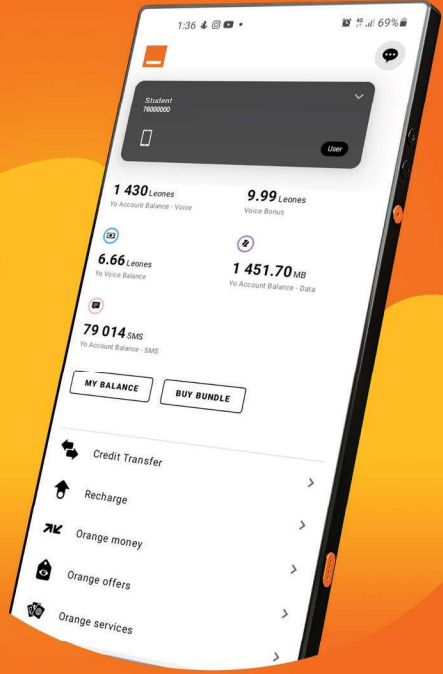
